INITIAL CHALLENGE

The Natural History Museum (NHM), one of the UK's most visited cultural landmarks, faces significant challenges when it comes to managing high-footfall entry points while ensuring comprehensive security.

During peak periods, up to 50 visitors per minute pass through the museum's entrances, creating congestion and posing a risk to crowd safety. Traditional, labour-intensive security methods, such as manual screening, could not keep up with the volume of visitors, and excessive queuing introduced new vulnerabilities outside the venue. Additionally, airport-style screening methods were seen as operationally restrictive and financially unfeasible for a cultural institution.

"High-footfall search and screening has emerged as one of the defining security challenges for major public venues. Balancing the protection of people, infrastructure, and collections against a spectrum of evolving threats remains a complex operational task. Excessive queuing can quickly introduce new vulnerabilities, effectively displacing risk outside the venue."
